


ADELAIDE INTERNATIONAL HOSPITALITY CHAMPIONS SUITE

* Please note that the event runs a day session and night session from Monday to Friday. It is not uncommon for day sessions to run late as this is a competitive event. Gates open for your guests to enter the venue including the centre court area at 5:00pm. The Champions Suite opens at 5:30pm. If day session matches are still in progress past 5:30pm then your guests are welcome to walk the complex including the outside courts where players may be practicing and matches may still be operating. They are also welcome to have a drink in the public bars. Once the day session is completed the venue will require 10-15 minutes to clean and re-set the corporate facility for the comfort of your guests. Note: this is only for the night session and if matches run past 5:30pm for the day session.
